



CREATING A LEGACY THROUGH CRY WOLF WRESTLING AT VISTA RIDGE HIGH SCHOOL

Students who are not disciplined in their academic studies risk opportunities to reach their full athletic potential. Building a legacy starts with an academically eligible team. The Vista Ridge High School Coed Wrestling Season operates from November through the State Championships in February. Our Cry Wolf Wrestling Club offers post-season, freestyle/greco-roman season, and pre-season activities from March through October.





We started Cry Wolf Wrestling because we believe it should be free to learn the coping skills taught by wrestling in an empowering environment.
